AZ Game & Fish Department

The Arizona Game and Fish Commission establishes policy for management, preservation, and harvest of wildlife.

The Game and Fish Department (AZGFD) make rules and regulations for managing, conserving, and protecting wildlife and fisheries resources, safe and regulated watercraft and off-highway vehicle operations for the benefit of the citizens of Arizona.

The AZGFD has developed a safety education program that is available online on their website. This course must be taken prior to registering your OHV. This course is required for any OHV 2500 pounds or less. This includes side by sides, UZV, ATV and single track.

The Arizona Game and Fish Department's all off-highway vehicle (OHV) safety education course includes instruction on the basic skills required to safely ride or operate an OHV. These include responsibilities of OHV riders to others and the environment, general information on preparing for the unexpected, additional educational resources, laws, rules and regulations for the safe, ethical and responsible operation and use of OHVs.

There are 7 Arizona Field Offices located in: Phoenix, Flagstaff, Kingman, Mesa, Pinetop, Tucson and Yuma, addresses and phone numbers are listed in the back of this book.

AZ Game and Fish Law Enforcement Officers have jurisdiction on all public lands.
